Recent Trail Maintenance and Development

2024 Work plan so far

- Town of Bancroft bridge completed
- Gravel grading 4 th line Havelock is to occur in November
- Gravel added in different parts of the trail network
- As part of the ICIP grant further aboriginal consultation has continued
- Design of bridge some bridge structures and further investigation of some bridge structures need to occur to determine the life span
- Gravel added on the trails near Lake St Peter
- Gravel added on the trails near Gilmour
- North Frontenac crown land trail improvements completed
- Grading completed on the trail network Kaladar to Sharbot Lake Tweed Madoc Marmora Stirling Havelock highway 62 to Bancroft and Corbyville to Stirling in some spots gravel was added as required
- 15 bridge were redecked
- 35 or more bridges cleaned as required by the engineer now completed
- Quinte west trail completed
- More new stop signs have been put up
- Marmora mine trail improvements gravel added completed
- Grass cutting is completed
- Tender for trail improvements Madawaska area 3 culverts will be replaced
- On going maintenance year round clean up fallen trees and debris, regular patrols unplug culverts and replace signage when required
- GGG tenders for bridges and other work

EOTA operates and maintains a year- round shared use recreational trail system
